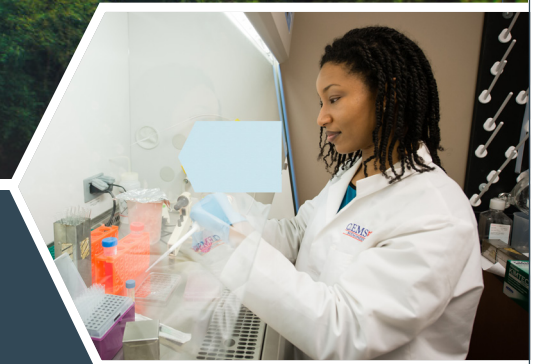


2ND ANNUAL HARRIET & JERRY DEMPSEY RESEARCH CONFERENCE
